

# Chit-Chat

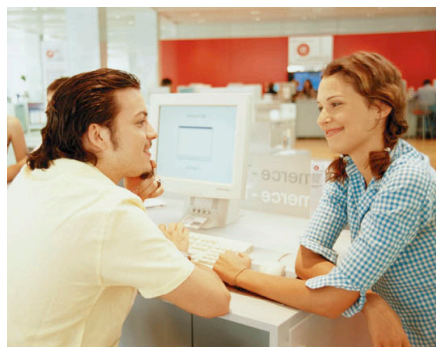
